a Very Happy Ending for One-Hundred Lives in Peril 🐕



The rescue world is always engaged in a never-ending flurry of activity. Someone always needs help, medical attention or a fresh start. However, this time, this phone call, this need seemed at first to be over-whelming. ARC has been through large scale rescues before due to hoarding, neglect or natural disasters. This time, with one hundred cats, Trust Again Pet Shelter (TAPS) in Wauchula, FL found itself with no funds, no resources and only one staff person.

We had three months to save one hundred cats. We were also the last hope because TAPS was being turned down by every shelter due to COVID financial struggles.

The first cats to arrive at ARC were the dozens that needed intensive care and would require recovery time. Then we placed calls to Gulf Coast Humane Society, Cape Coral Animal Shelter and Puffy Paws to see if they would be willing to take some of the healthy and "ready to adopt" kitties. Thanks to them, over fifty-five cats were safe. The other forty-five came to ARC with three final ones bringing up the rear in time for Christmas! TAPS Board member, Danielle White, dedicated herself to coordinating intake dates with ARC and personally providing transportation. Rest easy Danielle because your fur-babies are safe.

ARC would like to especially thank the two "Anonymous Foundations" that provided funding so this rescue could move forward. They put ARC in a position to be able to help and we are deeply grateful. Please consider adopting a "Wauchula Kitty". Every one of those still waiting at ARC have amazing personalities and are ready to love you forever!

Year-End Letter from **ARC's Board President**

To say that this past year has presented significant challenges would, of course, be an understatement to almost anyone. For us, the challenges created by COVID-19 could have easily been detrimental to our mission. Notice I said, "Could have been."

Simply put, our mission is to not only provide a unique type of shelter to our 400 residents, but to also offer exceptional, compassionate care. We are renowned for going the extra mile medically, and we strive to provide daily affection and interaction with all of our animals. This level of care and compassion is administered by an extremely hardworking and dedicated team of animal care employees and administrative staff. Behind them, stands a creative and committed Board of Trustees.

We are proud to say that throughout this pandemic, our employees never had to worry that their paycheck would be short or their jobs would be in danger of disappearing. ARC achieved this, when many for-profit businesses could not, through our knack for strategic planning. We routinely prepare for disasters, such as hurricanes, and always aim to be ready for the unexpected.

We also protected our employees by altering the way we conduct tours and adoptions. A new appointment-only system was implemented to reduce traffic and maintain social distancing on property. Additionally, we temporarily restricted access to volunteers, knowing that we might have to rely on them as an adjunct to our animal care staff in the event of an outbreak among our paid employees. Thus far, our staff has remained healthy.

As a 501(c)(3) organization, we rely solely on our own abilities, dedication and creativity to fund a rather substantial annual budget. A large component of this funding comes from events. As you might imagine, crowded events were a little difficult to execute this year. We were forced to cancel our Casino Royale event, and our flagship Starlight Auction saw less than half the attendance of 2019. Despite substantially decreased attendance and significantly fewer auction items, we still reached a near record level of sponsorships, and raised \$145,000! I, along with the rest of ARC's Board, cannot thank enough, the local businesses that gave so generously as sponsors, in spite of almost certainly dealing with financial hardships of their own.

As we move forward into 2021, we will continue to protect our employees' health by utilizing the new protocols put in place in 2020. Our focus will continue to be caring for, and finding forever homes for, our wonderful residents. We will always take on the challenging medical cases that other shelters are forced to turn away. And we will focus on expansion! Thanks to the amazing generosity of a few special donors, 2021 will see the construction of another feline housing building, as well as a state-of-the-art medical clinic. We also have another project in the works with one of our most beloved, long-term donors!

With the ongoing support of our amazing community, staff, volunteers and donors, we will continue to build on our nearly 33-year history of advocating for animals that cannot do so for themselves. We look forward to all that the new year will bring to the Animal Refuge Center!

We'd also like to thank all the on-line donors who raised enough funds for two self-propelled mowers for the dog aisles/yard.






ARC's 26th Starlight Auction A Magical Night!
