- 4. Freedom to express normal behavior by providing sufficient space, proper facilities and, if desired, company of the animal's own kind.

5. Freedom from fear and distress by avoiding overcrowding and providing sufficient enrichment and safe hiding spaces.





Many volunteers attend the Starlight Auction, and this year was no exception. However, this year Sylvia DiFolco attended for the first time since 2003 without her beloved mother, Gertrude Resch, both shelter volunteers. Gerti died in September at the age of 91. All our volunteers are special people but Sylvia and Gerti were among a select group who become medical fosters. They willingly took on the task of end-of-life care for Jewels, who was just short of 12 years old and diagnosed with cancer while still awaiting adoption when Sylvia and Gerti came into her life. Though ARC bares all costs of treatment, which can be expensive, nothing takes the place of a home and finally Jewels found a home. Jewels survived 2 ½ years after the diagnosis in large part because she was living in a home surrounded by a loving family. Sylvia recalls that from the start Jewels made herself right at home finding a comfy spot to nap on her new bed and was able to lead the way back to her new home on her first walk. Gerti enjoyed Jewels' companionship while Sylvia was at work. She had Jewels to care for and think about daily and she was never lonely. Jewels needed her. Gerti and Sylvia were overjoyed at being able to bring comfort to an elderly dog near life's end and Gerti and Sylvia loved Jewels dearly.

Some might be hesitant to volunteer thinking that there is no task that fits their circumstances quite right. There are many ways volunteers can support ARC. Gerti and Sylvia found a way by fostering Jewels and for Jewels, this was life-changing and likely life-extending.

Prior to her passing, Gerti expressed her wish that friends and family make donations to ARC in her memory and Sylvia made the first donation of Gerti's memorial funds on the night of the auction. Many were made from Sylvia's co-workers at NeoGenomics. Sylvia is thankful for this generosity, and she knows that Gerti is too. ARC is thankful for Sylvia and Gerti for caring for our Jewels, for making Jewels' last year's her best years, and for their support of ARC. Rest in peace Gerti, we know Jewels was waiting at the Rainbow Bridge and that you are both together again.
