### Ribbon Cutting Ceremony Ushers in a Grand Opening!

From a long-time dream to a crowning reality, the Sharon Bodenhafer Critter Care Clinic is now open for ARC cats and dogs. This state-of-the-art, 2500 sq. foot clinic has everything needed to provide surgical procedures, dental care, heartworm treatments, respiratory care, spay-neuters, and so much more. Our exam room is complete with a digital imaging system which allows us to share images to local orthopedic/cardiac or cancer specialists or even to those across the country! This allows for the fastest diagnosis possible in order to resolve a pet's issue or to know when an off-site resolution is more appropriate. Separate air systems for cat and dog recovery units deter cross-contamination between them and the surgical suite.

Over thirty people attended the grand opening to honor Sharon's memory and thank her husband, Chuck, for bestowing this amazing gift to ARC. His hours of dedication to the personal touches were particular evident in the lobby where Sharon's portrait hangs. In addition, an entire wall is a mural depicting the Rainbow Bridge, personal pets and her love of all animals.

We hope to honor Sharon and thank Chuck, in the best way possible, by utilizing this clinic to its' fullest capability for the benefit of the cats and dogs in SW Florida and beyond.
