Letter from the President

These last two years or so have seen great improvements in the infrastructure at the *Animal Refuge Center*. With the help of the original donor, we fully remodeled the *Gribble Canine Training Center*, installing 14 beautiful kennels for the purposes of intake quarantine and increased safety for our dogs in the event of natural disaster. Our old Welcome Center was demolished and replaced with the beautiful new *Brighter Beginnings Adoption Center*. Two aging feline buildings were completely remodeled (funded by two Board members), giving us the new *Zippy's Cottage* and *Harley House*. Lastly, we replaced 5 existing, and added 2 new, stormproof canine lodges.

2020 will be no different! Construction of a new 4,000 SqFt cat building will begin in the coming months. This project was funded in one part by a very large estate donation, and the remainder by proceeds from November 2019's *Starlight Auction* donation item. Hundreds of attendees raised their hands to give, and the result was amazing.

We also have another VERY exciting new project beginning on the horizon as well! Our current 1200 Sq Ft on-site medical center will be replaced with a beautiful, new, state of the art clinic. The new clinic (Name TBA in a future issue!) will more than double the size of our current medical center, and allow us to vastly improve the comfort and care of residents who are sick or undergoing long periods of treatment for medical issues like Heartworm disease, cancer, or orthopedic procedures. Our medical staff already provides an excellent level of care in a very small, aging building. The new clinic will make our capabilities that much greater. This massive undertaking was also underwritten by an extremely generous individual donor.

So how do we continue to improve, expand and reinvent ourselves at ARC? The answer is simple. We are able to grow and thrive because we are guided by a Board of Trustees that has the utmost vision and commitment to the organization. And of course, our residents are cared for by a staff that loves them as if they were their own. We are able to make projects like these come to fruition through the simple generosity of everyday supporters like you! We are a 501c3, non-profit. We receive no help whatsoever from the county, state, or government. We raise the money that allows us to improve and expand through fundraisers and events, grants and appeals, and interactions with the public that gravitate them to our cause.

You, yes YOU, can be a hero to our mission. The aggregate of even the smallest donations, can become the springboard to something wonderful. We were so pleased to be a sponsor of the Florida Everblades 2019-2020 season! Go Blades!


