## GOOD THINGS COME TO THOSE WHO WAIT!


It has been a long and convoluted process to construct a new 4,000-foot cat building but FINALLY it is done! ARC has undergone a lot of expansion over the past thirty years but this particular project seemed to hit all the road bumps. Perhaps a sign of the times is the extrememly long permitting process. Then we had to get in line for construction material, then deal with lumber costs going stratospheric! Topping off a year delay was a new requirement installing two ten thousand galleon water tanks and a fire truck road extension in the event of a fire. That almost brought construction to a screeching halt but thankfully some Foundation support was granted and that requirement met.

Now known as the Handran House and the Stanfield House, cats are being shifted from pods that will undergo some renovations. Specifically, we have four cat building that are in need of converting linoleum flooring to epoxy floors. We already shifted kittens from the Maises House into the Handran House. Once Doc's Painting begins replacing the flooring in the other four houses, it will be musical chairs shifting cats from one house to another until all are updated! We will need to stock up on Temptations to reward all our kitties for being so good regarding the move.
