We reach out to county shelters for pets that have run "out of time". We offer complicated surgical procedures to restore health to a new intake, take on the pets that are in need of longer medical treatment for mange or heartworm eradication and we seek out foster homes for those that need frequent medications to control diabetes, thyroid or heart issues.

They stayed with us for a short time before getting adopted together, to what we hoped would be a forever home. We know that life has a way of throwing a curveball from time to time, and sometimes things change in unpredictable ways. That's why, at the Animal Refuge Center, we have it written into our adoption contract that if for any reason you cannot keep the dog or cat you got from us, that they are to be returned to us directly. As fate would have it, something must have changed in Bunny and Cottontail's lives. They found themselves abandoned at a shelter in South Carolina. Fortunately, the kind staff at *Jasper Animal Rescue* contacted ARC to let us know that they had our sweet hounds. The microchips still listed us as their original home.

Once an ARC dog, always an ARC dog. In quite typical fashion, we decided to go get these girls and give them a second chance at a forever home. Executive Director, Wayne Leinen, and Animal Caretaker, Kurt Donovan, drove through the night all the way to South Carolina, arriving just as the shelter opened. They were greeted by the two friendly hounds who howled and bayed with excitement. Luckily, they were not so noisy in the cargo van on the long trip back to ARC. Now that they are back safely with us, we are looking for that special forever home they were always meant to have. While we always hope that an adoption is forever, know that when you adopt from us, we always welcome back our dogs and cats should something come up that necessitates their return.
